Fly to Brazil: All participants depart for Brazil on Saturday (2 days before Monday tour start date) to arrive in Brasilia on Sunday. Group spends 1 night in Carlton Hotel. Group departs hotel and begins the official tour Monday morning after check-out.

Return Home: All participants depart on the last day of the tour: 2 Saturdays after arrival for 2-week tours; and Second Saturday evening after arrival for one week tours

NOTE #1: If purchasing tickets without a travel agent, make sure you give yourself at least 2 hours to clear Immigration and Customs before a connecting flight from Sao Paulo/Rio/Manaus to Brasilia. If you are not traveling to/from the Brasilia airport to the pousada with the group van, then you must pay your own taxi fare, approximate \$100 U.S.

NOTE #2: Upon 1st entry into a new country (Brazil or USA), you must go through Immigration, pickup your bags at baggage claim and clear Customs. Make sure you allow at least 1.5 hours for this process prior to making any connecting flight.



VISA

Travel to Brazil from the United States requires a tourism visa. The tourism visa is valid for 10 years. Use the consulate the covers your state of residence. For example, the Brazilian Consulate in Los Angeles area is : <http://losangeles.itamaraty.gov.br/en-us/> located at

- **visa applications** are received from 10 am to 12 pm **BY [APPOINTMENT ONLY](#)**
- **visa pick-ups** are received from 9 am to 12 pm

Allow 10-15 business days for process of visa by the Consulate in Los Angeles. An appointment is necessary to apply for the Visa in person. No appointment is necessary for Visa pick-up. No mailing is done .

IMPORTANT: Remember to make sure your passport is valid for 6 months from the date of departure and you have actual blank pages remaining in your passport.



BRASILIA – CARLTON HOTEL

Group members purchase whatever plane fare they can get to arrive in Brasilia on Sunday, 1day before Tour Start Date in December.

Rev. Kathleen will reserve single rooms for each participant unless they specify they are sharing a room with another person. Everyone will rest and relax for one night before the group departs together Monday morning for Brasilia Tour and BBQ luncheon. Group participants can use a credit card to pay for their hotel room and room expenses like dinner and minibar. For those checking-in before noon on Sunday, the hotel will charge an extra half-day room rate. The breakfast buffet goes from 6am – 10am every day so if you arrive early on Sunday, be sure to go to the buffet and enjoy yourself before resting. Breakfast on Monday is included in hotel rate.

A taxi from Brasilia airport to the Carlton Hotel is approximately R\$50 + luggage fees for the 10 min drive to hotel. The taxi driver will tell you the total cost including luggage fees so only pay what he asks.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

The Casa requires all participants to supply proof of travel, health, hospitalization and hospital transportation insurance for this journey. I therefore need you to provide me with your medical insurance policy number and a phone contact (include this on the Tour Application form) so I can verify that your plan offers full coverage in Brazilian territory. If your company does not provide this coverage, I recommend Travel Guard or AirMed Insurance:

They both have individual or family plans and their insurance packages cover emergency medical and dental expenses, emergency medical evacuation/repatriation, flight delays and cancellations, trip interruption, baggage loss, and baggage delay for a very reasonable fee.

IMPORTANT: Once you have purchased your airline tickets you have 2 weeks from date of ticket purchase to contact Travel Guard and buy insurance. This will ensure you are covered for all pre-existing medical conditions and that you will receive full coverage.

PACKING

Do NOT over pack! Realize that during your trip to the Casa, you will have spiritual intervention. This means that you should not carry or lift anything over 10 lbs on your trip home. ***NO backpacks please!***

Travel light: one medium suitcase and a small carry-on is more than enough for 2-weeks. I suggest wheeled luggage so you can pull in through the airport. You will not want anything heavy on your back or shoulders on the return home.

NOTE: There are internet cafes to check email and Skype home. The hotel has WIFI and allows free calls to USA and Canada. Also you can call home at Fruitti's smoothie restaurant for reasonable rates. Remember you are in a "spiritual hospital". Plan to focus on YOU and limit contact with family and friends back home while you are in treatment during the first week.

CLOTHING

Casa days are Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. The Entities of the Casa request that you wear white clothing (top and bottom) for the healing sessions. Bring a minimum of two sets of white attire. You can have your clothes laundered but return time is based on the weather. Casual



summer clothing is best for all other times. The temperature in Abadiânia is consistent, averaging 70-85F degrees during the day. It may be cooler at night and early mornings. A light jacket or sweater is recommended. Also pack a rain jacket and umbrella if you are traveling from November to April, which is the wet season. May to October is generally dry and no rain gear is required. Basic clothing and equipment list includes the following:

1. All prescription medication (in your carry-on) and plenty to last at least 2 weeks
2. Electrical adapter-220v (for use with hairdryer, laptop, iPad)
3. 1 pair casual walking/hiking shoes or sneakers, sandals
4. 1-2 pair of shorts
5. 1-2 pair of light cotton slacks or skirts
6. 2-4 short sleeve cotton shirts, blouses or t-shirts
7. 2 long sleeved cotton shirts or blouses
8. 1 sweater or sweatshirt or hoodie
9. Socks, underwear, sleepwear
10. Rain or windbreaker
11. Good sunglasses
12. Sun screen, chapstick with sun block, a brim hat for the sun
13. Umbrella (for rain or sun protection regardless of season)
14. Flashlight
15. Alarm clock or cell phone you use to set an alarm
16. Insect repellent (especially during wet season: Jan-April)
17. Personal first aid supplies and/or feminine products
18. Soap, shampoo, standard toiletries and personal items like hairdryer
19. Day pack or camera case and camera equipment
20. Swimsuit and towel/sarong (for visit to the Sacred Waterfall)
21. White clothing (for formal Casa Days: Wed, Thur, Fri)
22. Flip-flop or warm weather sandals.
23. Shoes that can get wet in rainy season and dry easily like rubber sandals (or puddle boots).
24. Duct tape (if you wish to take a case of blessed water home vs. a few bottles in luggage)
25. Zip lock bags to bring home blessed water (gallon size)



Bring clothes to layer since wet season can get chilly when damp.

MONEY

The currency of Brazil is the Brazilian Reais, BR (to get a sense of the exchange rate visit <http://www.xe.com/ucc/>). It is difficult to suggest how much money one needs to exchange for this trip as everyone has a different sense of what is 'essential' and the exchange rate changes. That said, \$400.00 is adequate sum to bring for **essentials not included** in the trip itinerary. I always go to my bank (Bank of America) and order my foreign currency before I leave for Brazil That way it is not a problem. This would be in addition to money for herbs (\$50 – \$60 for each prescription you are given by the Entities), blessed water (either 2 or 3 BR), crystal light therapy bed sessions (R20 per 20 minute treatment), food outside our hotel, and gratuities (R50 per week for staff at hotel). If you choose not to get your foreign currency from your bank in the US, exchange \$50-\$100 in airport before you leave. You will get a better rate in Abadiânia versus the airport so do not exchange much in airport. I will take you to the place in Abadiânia if you prefer to wait to exchange you money.

Do not bring traveler's cheques! You can purchase items from the Casa gift shop using US dollars and Visa/MasterCard credit/debit cards. Some stores take credit cards (Visa/MasterCard). There is an ATM machine in the San Raphael hotel front lobby but it can be out of money for days or a week. You can purchase an international phone card, at Brasilia airport, for your stay- it costs 50BR and it is good for 30 minutes. Card can easily be used at pay phone. You may also instruct family to call you at the hotel, usually during dinner hours 6:00-7:00pm. Cell phones and other international cards do not work well in Abadiânia. If you have a laptop, Skype works great to call home or you can pay to call home using one of the phone booths at the local smoothie bar.

URGENT: Remember to call your Credit Card Company and Bank before you leave and tell them you are traveling to Brazil. If you wish to use an ATM Credit or Debit card during your trip the bank must know this in advance or it will block your card.



HEALTH

Vaccines are normally NOT REQUIRED for a trip to Abadiania. Please consult your physician about recommended vaccinations and medications. The Center for Disease Control can be contacted at (800) 232-4636 or <http://www.cdc.gov>. Their recommendation for a yellow fever vaccine changes according to conditions in the State of Goias. Also, if you are traveling through Manaus it may be necessary to show proof of yellow fever vaccination or a doctor's note. It is important that you discuss this with your own physician as a yellow fever shot is not advised for those suffering from immune issues or sensitivities. A hepatitis A vaccine is also sometimes advised but not required.

It is not recommended to drink or use water from the tap to brush your teeth if you are extremely sensitive to water changes. You can purchase bottled water, to brush your teeth or simply use blessed water purchased at the Casa. Remember that for your stay in Abadiânia drinking blessed water (blessed by the Entities) is part of the Casa healing protocol.

You may want to take a 12 pack of small bottled water home with you or a few bottles in your checked luggage. You can put 3 small bottles in a gallon zip lock bag. I will instruct you as to how to use the water once you return home. Be sure to bring a roll of duct tape if you want to take a case home. If taking home a case, you will pack these bottles in a small box to ensure bottles do not break in airplane. This box will be your 2nd piece of free checked luggage and you will be plastic wrap it at the Brasilia airport. I will provide you with full details on this a few days prior to your departure.

CASA PROTOCOLS

Please know you will return from the Casa refreshed and rejuvenated by the love and healing energy that embraces you there. As with Western medicine, not everyone who visits João de Deus is guaranteed a speedy, or one-time, physical cure. The Entities will tell you when your healing is complete. Spiritual work takes time, so assume they will want you to return and continue your spiritual work as possible.



Everyone receives a healing on the spiritual level. Some see physical changes during the trip and some take time as the healing unfolds over months or years. At the Casa, the Entities (Beings of Light) support you in your healing but they cannot override your free will to accept their help and do your own part in your healing process. Be mindful that this healing will occur at its own pace, so please be gentle with yourself and have patience with this process.

At the Casa you will be expected to observe certain dietary and life restrictions. This is a spiritual hospital so you are asked to **refrain from** strenuous activity, hiking, jogging, and other rigorous activities. You are asked to go inward and slow down, spending as much time as possible in reflective solitude or meditation, not only during Casa days but throughout the entire trip. This is especially important if you receive intervention. Rest and recuperation is vital. Realize you will be a patient.

In addition, those who receive **intervention are required to abstain from all sexual activity for a period of 40 days.** This rule holds true for the **1st intervention only.** For subsequent interventions (physical or spiritual) you are asked to abstain from sexual activity until after the spiritual stitches are removed a week later. Sexual activity means any rise of sexual energies.

You also cannot receive other energy work for 40 days after each intervention. The only healing work that is permitted in this 40 days is the crystal light bed because it is a portal to the Entities to work on you directly.

If the Entities prescribe Casa herbs, you will need to forego alcoholic beverages, fertilized eggs, and chili peppers including black/white/cayenne pepper spices and hot sauces for the duration of the treatment, which is until you finish all the herbs. *Unless you get eggs directly from a farm where it's possible to have an embryo in the egg, all eggs in local stores are already non-fertilized eggs to pass inspection.* Remember that these dietary restrictions also hold for individuals whose photographs you present to the Entity for healing and they receive a prescription. If they are prescribed herbs, they must adhere to the dietary protocol once they receive the herbs. And remember, you must obtain permission from individuals who ask for healing. No dietary restrictions apply for those who seek a blessing from the Entities.



This is not a shopping trip or a trip to decide you want to do this work or everything all at once. It is your first spiritual journey to John of God. A trip for your personal development and growth, not a time to socialize and hang out. Although, we will enjoy our time together and time with each other. I have found that the people that go on this journey together were meant to go together. Please always be respectful and kind to all.

Rest assured that I will review all Casa procedures and guidelines with you while in Abadiânia, so that you are fully informed and at ease with this process. We will also attend an English Casa Orientation on Tuesday 5pm as a group. Please feel free to call me if you have any questions or concerns after reading this information. That's why I'm here. I look forward to speaking with you.
